ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this organization is the Eagle Heights Neighborhood Association (herein after referred to as the "Association"). It is an unincorporated association located in Irondequoit, New York.

ARTICLE II. BOUNDARIES

The Boundaries of the Association are Titus Avenue between Cooper Road and Oakview Drive including Eastgate Drive, Westgate Drive and Shadowlawn Court; and Dake Avenue between Cooper Road and List Avenue.

ARTICLE III. MISSION, PURPOSE, & GOALS

The mission statement of the Association is: We are a volunteer association striving to make our neighborhood a better place to live.

To promote the Association's mission, it will:

- 1. Plan for the future of the neighborhood as well as protect, promote and improve its current assets.
- 2. Connect neighbors in order to celebrate the character of our community and strengths of our residents.
- 3. Represent all residents of the Association promoting the maintenance of and fostering the conditions for desirable residential housing.
- 4. Provide granular communication on town developments and assistance wherever able.

This includes but is not limited to will:

- 1. Assisting residents to advocate for and receive high quality services from public and private institutions.
- 2. Developing and foster relationships within the community.
- 3. Facilitating forums and discussions on issues of interest to residents.
- 4. Planning, organizing and implementing activities for residents.

This organization is organized exclusively for charitable purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Therefore, no money raised or earned by the Association may be distributed to its members or officers except for reasonable compensation for services rendered or to make payments in the furtherance of the purpose of the organization.

No substantial part of the activities of shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. The Association shall not intervene in any political campaigns on behalf of, or in opposition to any candidates for public office.

The Association shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
